EVANGELISM, PRISON AND HOSPITAL MINISTRIES AND OUR CHURCH OPEN DOOR SOUTH

In 2018, Grace and Peace led 396 people to the Lord through our programs, street evangelism and our church, Open Door South. When we walk through the streets in the poor neighborhoods, it becomes a social event for the Dominicans as we approach them and ask if we can visit with them. Grace and Peace believes in relational evangelism. We want to develop a relationship with each one that accepts the Lord. We also go into the local prison and hospital to spread the Gospel. When we go in, we always take some sort of gift as a way to open up the conversation. Sometimes it's food, sometimes it's toothbrushes and toothpaste. Those we minister to have pretty much nothing. Their goal each day is to eat. They will spend a lot of their day trying to figure that out. Even in the hospital, nothing is provided for them even if they become a patient. They must bring their own bedding, and buy their medicines once diagnosed even if they are staying in the hospital. A bowl of soup sometimes is all they may eat for that day. At our church, Open Door South, they also did street evangelism, leading 49 people to the Lord. Ten of these new Christians are

now regularly attending services there.

In 2018 the Widow Program had so many blessings! Aola and Magdalena, both whom we thought were Christians, officially gave their hearts to the Lord after we felt an urgency to go and visit with them. Victoria, the mother of one of the most murderous thugs in our town who accepted the Lord while in prison (Victor), received a new roof and kitchen, both of which were rat infested. Victoria said she has the peace of the Lord as she walks with Christ. She told us she rededicated her life to the Lord through our program. She also takes her sister with her, in hopes that she will accept the Lord. Carmelita Morla was very sick with Amoebas a few months ago. Grace and Peace was able to get her the medical care she needed. Had she gone on much longer, she would have died. Elva Esperanza was attending a widow Bible study regularly but when asked if she wanted to accept the Lord, she would always say, "No." Several of us began to pray for her regularly, for the Lord to soften her heart. Then she fell in January, was hospitalized and Keila's mother, Ofelia, led her to the Lord as she visited her in the hospital. months later, Elva passed away. It is our primary goal that every widow, when they pass away, know the Lord as their savior. To date, we are grateful to report that every one since the start of this program 18

years ago, was saved. Elupita Feliz was homeless. She was praying for help. She barely had food. All she kept saying was how much she was suffering before she found our widow program. Not only did the Lord provide her with food, He also opened up one of our houses. God answered ALL of her prayers. Margarita Garcia, when she came into the program, was sleeping on the floor. Grace and Peace remedied that quickly with a new bed. We also bought her a new cooktop stove. What a blessing and privilege it is for Bill and I, along with our Grace and Peace family, to be able to provide a house, a bed or a new roof for widows that were being rained on for years before coming into the program. They are also plugged into a good church that commits to helping them in any way they can because Grace and Peace has amazing supporters who make a way to help our widows when they are destitute. Most importantly is that they hear the Gospel and have made a commitment to the Lord before they pass. In 2018, we cared for 97 widows.



THE CHILDREN'S PROGRAM

Grace and Peace ministers to 300 children every Saturday and Sunday in 6 different programs. We've been ministering to children since 2000. They are taught the Word of God and given eggs to help meet their protein needs. In one of our programs, 5 children who have been in the program since they were little are now faithfully attending church and are involved in leadership. We are beginning to see a lot of fruit. One of those children would have regular convulsions and fevers. He was prayed over many times and the Lord healed him. another program, 2 young men also grew up in our program and are now involved in leadership. More fruit, what a blessing! The cost to help a child is \$5 a month. You can sponsor 5 children for as little as \$25 a month or 10 children for \$50 a month.
